# V. <u>Finance Update</u>

Budget summary

- i. \$28,665 starting bank balance
- ii. \$21,461 end of year balance
- Income
  - i. Budgeted Income-\$30,450
  - ii. Income to Date-\$24,232
    - 1. Larger income sources include Miss Chocolate, Scholastic Book Fair, Beautification GoFundMe, and General Fund Donations
- Expenses
  - i. Budgeted Expenses- \$37,654
  - ii. Expenses to Date-\$23,520
    - 1. School Garden, Playworks, Academic Enrichment, Teacher Grants, and Classroom Reimbursements among the larger expenses
- Budgetary Projections
  - i. Projected income estimates-
    - 1. Approx. \$9600 could be raised by the end of the year

Grown Up Fundraiser (\$500), Book Fair (\$200), Fun Run (\$500), Spring Dance (\$2000), Beautification Fund (\$1500), Plant Sale (\$900), School Supply Fund (\$2000)

- 2. Estimates based on information from previous years
- 3. Projection estimates discussed
  - a. Spring estimates for Book Fair and Beautification may be too high
  - b. Rain impacted Plant Sale last year, hoping to raise more this year
- ii. Larger remaining expenses-
  - 1. Approx. \$9600 to be spent by the end of the year

Garden (\$2200), Classroom Reimbursements (\$2600), Teacher Mini Grants (\$1700), Staff Appreciation (\$2000), Graduation Trophies (\$1000)

- iii. Projected expenses from budgetary lines not used to date
  - 1. \$2838 in residual budgeted expenses
  - 2. \$2400 in expenses from unused/potentially unneeded budgetary lines

Back-to-School Night (\$100), Career Day (\$50.00), Clean-Up Days (\$100), Extracurricular Clubs (\$400), Family Fun (\$300), Playground (\$500), Science Fun Day (\$200), and Trip Supplements (\$750)

- 1. Discussed individual budgetary lines to assess need
  - a. Funds for Trip Supplements, Clean Up Days, and Extracurricular Clubs may be needed and should remain as budgeted
- 2. \$1,050 in expenses identified as unneeded this fiscal year
  - a. \$200 line amount for Science Fun Day can be reduced to \$100
  - Expenses budgeted for Back-to-School Night (\$100), Career Day(\$50),
     Family Fun (\$300), and Playground (\$500) not needed this fiscal year-\$950 in total budgeted funds

- c. \$950 + \$100 from Science Fun Day = \$1,050 available
- Discussed reallocating identified funds to Board Discretionary Fund
  - i. Flexible budget line that can be used to support unbudgeted requests
    - 1. Only \$100 budgeted this fiscal year
    - 2. Additional funds would allow PTA to support worthwhile teacher requests not accounted for in the current budget
  - ii. Voted to move \$1,050 to Board Discretionary Fund
    - 1. Motions to approve made
    - 2. Approved; Yes-20, No- 0, Abstain-0
- Trip Supplements
  - i. Upper school seeking trip support from PTA
    - 1. Looking to fund sibling scholarships for end of year trips
      - a. 7 sibling pairs in upper school that may need support
      - b. Trip to Baltimore will cost \$115/student
      - c. Trip to Neshaminy Park will cost \$40/student
    - 2. PTA has given \$500 in trip support to the upper school in the past
      - a. School may be able to provide additional financial support
      - b. Could ask for community donations
- Winter Donation Campaign
  - i. Was very successful
  - ii. Over \$4000 raised
  - iii. Thank you to all who contributed!
