2. Reggie Streater:

- Estimated time for work will be done and he says that virtual will not go on in perpetuity
- District has allocated \$24 million for asbestos remediation and are making concerted efforts -- finding things that should have been remediated years ago
- "Not a Frankford level problem at Henry"
 - From the chat: "Because it is a fluid situation, I can say is that the repairs and process is looking good. The District is working at a feverish pace to ensure that the remediation will be within the two weeks as was originally communicated. At this point, it does not appear to be a Frankford level event."
- District is trying to have a swing space program for any and all schools who close. But in NW Philly, most schools are full and they are still looking for swing space here
- Shouldn't have rolling closures in perpetuity

3. Other Notes:

- PSSAs might happen the minute we reopen school -- could affect test scores and negatively impact students like 7th graders

4. BRAINSTORMING:

- West Mount Airy Neighbors and Go Mt. Airy have reached out to PTA
 - Andrea Calabretta is part of Mt. Airy CDC and reiterated their support
- Invite current political candidates to stand with us be with us
- Make a short video that we can show our kids about why it's unsafe to be in schools with asbestos
- This lack of funding will eventually affect all district schools. Is it too much to suggest a district wide strike and rally at City Hall or 440 and Harrisburg on Monday?
- Develop an action plan that can be used for other schools (the counselor should do this, providing resources for parents to talk about asbestos with their kids)
